

MPAC delivers an assessment roll annually to municipalities and the Province of Ontario to support the calculation of property and education taxes. These assessed values are used by municipalities to distribute taxes, not determine them.








In 2025, Ontario saw almost **81,000** new residential homes constructed. Here's the breakdown by type.










New Assessment in Residential Condominiums








New Assessment in Seasonal Properties













New Assessment (Population under 15,000)








New Assessment in Greater Golden Horseshoe














